This one-day Paediatric Emergency First Aid course has been designed for those who have an interest in child and infant basic life support. If you have a professional interest i.e you are child minder or School teacher etc then it fulfils partly the requirements of OFSTED and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) In order to obtain the full qualification, you must attend this course and also the course J/600/2037 – Managing Paediatric illness and injury. Delegates must be a minimum of 14 years of age.
